PUPIL PREMIUM – 2016-2017



The pupil premium is additional funding given by the Government to publicly fund schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

Those in receipt of the Pupil Premium will fall into one of these categories:

- The pupil is eligible for Free School Meals.
- The pupil has been eligible for Free School Meals at some point in the last 6 years.
- The pupil is a child of parent(s) in the Armed Forces.

At St Teresa's School the targeted and strategic use of Pupil Premium will support us in achieving our vision that every pupil can achieve their full potential, irrespective of background or starting point. The money is used to benefit all Pupil Premium children and supports higher, as well as lower ability children by extending the provision on offer.

We currently have 97 pupils eligible for Pupil Premium (£118,800)

Pupil Premium will support our pupils in the following areas:

| Education Welfare and Support | £500 | Support families in overcoming barriers to attendance and learning. |
| Outdoor Resources and Provision | £5,000 | To continue to develop the learning environment in Key Stage 1 |
| Curriculum Enrichment | £16,700 | Enrichment opportunities including: More parental workshops and resources to engage parents in learning. Additional activities for higher attainers Additional leadership training for pupils , eg sports leaders, digital leaders, chaplaincy teams Development of school library/Junior Librarian to increase attainment and enjoyment in reading. |
| School visits | £3,000 | Financial support where required |
| IT Equipment | £17,000 | Interactive Screens, Notebooks, TVs, Assessment Software Specialist support for staff and pupils |
