**PE Additional Funding**

**In PE we want to inspire young people to participate in and enjoy physical activity, and to recognise the importance of an active and healthy lifestyle which continues into adulthood.**

**We want to instil this through effective teaching and learning and we are constantly looking to move forward.**

**We aim to provide opportunities for pupils to assume responsibility for their own learning and to engage inquisitive minds.**

**Funding:**

In April 2013, the Government announced new funding of £150 million for physical education (PE) and sport. This funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision. At St Teresa's school, we receive approximately £9,000 annually.

We have decided to allocate this funding to deploy a PE and school sports specialist from 'First Grade Sports.' His name is Mr Moseley.

He is in school on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and his role at St Teresa's Catholic Primary School is to deliver PE to years 4, 5 and 6, as well as run and oversee fun activities and clubs both during lunchtime and after school.

Class teachers work alongside Mr Moseley to develop their skills in order to deliver high quality P.E. lessons.

At St Teresa's this year, the children will be taking part in our "Road to Rio" ahead of next year's Olympics and they will all be running as many laps of the playground and field during the last 10 minutes of lunchtime as possible. The aim, is to do over 300 laps to make it to the final destination of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, stopping along at famous countries on the way.

We also use the funding to deploy specialist coaches to teach after school clubs and for new equipment. This means that every child has the opportunity to enjoy and to be coached in a variety of sports.
