Uniform Code

All children should wear school shoes. No boots or fashion shoes are allowed.

The governors stipulate that no jewellery of any description, including studs, may be worn within school for reasons of safety. An analogue watch with a plain strap may be worn.

It is important that both girls' and boys' hair is kept neat and tidy at all times. Suitable plain brown or black hair bands should be worn for keeping long hair tied back. Fashion haircuts, mousse and hair gel are not allowed, the latter being a health and safety issue as they are highly flammable. No bows or pretty headbands. Boys' hair is to be **no shorter** than a Grade 2.
