Other Faiths Week

This will start on Monday 20th November, we will be exploring and sharing Other Faiths in school. All classes will be learning about Judaism and have the opportunity to explore traditions and celebrations within this religion. On Thursday 23rd November, Year 4, 5 and 6 will participate in the workshop, 'Sacred Spaces', led by the Jewish Museum, London. This will explore the importance and significance of the Synagogue, and routines and traditions of prayer in Judaism.

Class liturgical prayer workshop

As part of our Collective Worship provision at St Teresa's, pupil leadership of liturgical prayer is of high importance. We come together as a whole school, key stages and year groups throughout each week. All classes have the opportunity to plan and lead their class liturgical prayer to provide some reflective time during the busy school week to gather together and bring the message of scripture into focus.

Admission to Infant/Primary Education

The admissions process for entry into Foundation Year September 2023 will begin in November. If your child will be 5 during the academic year September 2024 to August 2025 you will need to be making an application at this time. Please ensure you also complete a Supplementary Form with details of your faith and provide a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate. The closing date for all applications is **15th January 2024**. Any applications submitted after this date will be classed as late. This could mean your child may not get a place.

St Teresa's will be open for prospective families to visit and have a look around the school before they submit their application. This will be on Thursday 9th November between 9.30am until 11.00am by appointment only. Please call the school office on 0115 9155762 to book your place.

Winter Weather
