#### Welcome back

#### <u>R.E</u>


The RE topics of this term are Families, Belonging and Waiting. We will be thinking about our families, what communities we belong to and coming up to Christmas we will be thinking about waiting during Advent.

#### **RSHE**

The children will be thinking about how God made all of his children out of love and for love. We will also be encouraging children to celebrate similarities and differences between people.

# **Literacy**

Our topics this term are 'What makes a good place to live?' looking at The Bog Baby. After half term we will be considering 'What does it feel like to be lost?' using the book Lost and Found. We will be focusing on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops when writing a sentence.



#### Maths

We will be focusing on basic counting skills and place value within 20. We will also be looking at addition and subtraction within 10.

#### Science

We are learning about materials. We will be identifying and comparing different materials and their properties. After half term we will be looking at the different seasons.

# Geography/History

In Geography we are learning about our local area. We will be looking at towns and cities, and different characteristics that they have.

We would really appreciate if you could talk to your child about these topics. Maybe go to the library and borrow some books about them.


#### Uniform

### Reading at home

Make sure your child practices their spellings too, these can be found inside their reading organisers each week. Spellings will be given out on Fridays and tested in school on the following Friday. Your child needs to bring their guided reading book to school **every day** so that they can read at school.

#### <u>Homework</u>

Please ensure that homework is completed and sent back to school. We set homework weekly, and it will be given out on a Friday. Please return it to school by Tuesday.

Please log on to Mathletics as we will set weekly tasks to help support your child's learning.

Please also log on to Reading eggs and access the 'Fast Phonics' app to complete the pathways in order for your child to achieve their certificates.
