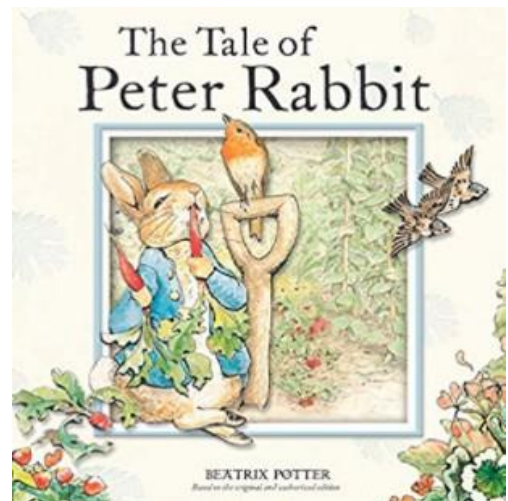
The RE topics of this term are Holy days and holidays, Being Sorry and Creation and Covenant.

Literacy

In Literacy we are looking at the story of Peter Rabbit and The rabbit problem. After half term, we will be looking at the story of Katie in London and Paddington at the palace. We will be focusing on full stops, using conjunctions such as 'and' and using language such as be- cause to provide explanations.

Maths

We will be focusing on recognising, adding and making equal groups. We will also be beginning to look at finding a half and a quarter of a shape or quantity. We will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s up to 100 for- wards and backwards.



Science

This term we are learning about Plants. We will be describing the features of a plant. We will learn about different types of trees and plants. We will be sorting them into groups such garden plants and wild plants. Please see knowledge organisers for more information. Don't forget to look after your bean plant and watch it grow.

History

In History, we will be looking at famous people from the local area such as Robin Hood. After half term we will be learning about The Royal Family.

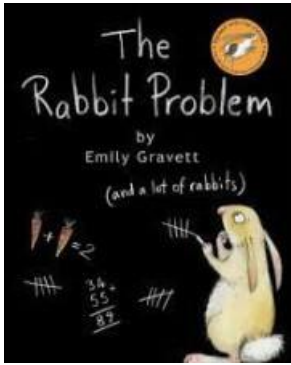
UNIFORM:
